SOUTHAMPTON POINTE SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The purpose of these rules is to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities, and to maximize the enjoyment of the pool by all owners and residents. Every resident is requested to read them carefully, and parents are urged to make sure that their children understand the rules and obey the person who is responsible for enforcing them.

I. <u>GENERAL</u>

Persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. The Association and Management assume no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use, or for loss or damage to personal property.

Hours of operation are from 8 am until 10 pm. Do not enter the pool area outside of the hours of operation.

II. POOL USAGE

Every resident is required to have their assigned Pool Pass card in their possession and displayed when using the pool or pool area.

Residents are allowed up to four (4) individual guests, per unit, to accompany during pool use, and property owner MUST be present at all times.

All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.

Children under twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at least 21 years old.

Children who are not toilet trained must wear rubber pants with tight-fitting elastic around the legs and waist while in the pool.

Running, pushing, wrestling or undue disturbance in or about the pool area is prohibited.

No oversized floats, water wings, drinking game floats (i.e. beer pong) or other play equipment may be used in the pool.

Food is not permitted to be consumed in the pool. Drinks and food must be consumed at least 4' away from pool. No food may be consumed in the immediate apron portions of the pool.

NO GLASS containers may be brought into the pool area.

No pets, wheeled vehicles other than wheel chairs, or baby strollers will be permitted in the pool area.

No spouting of water or other unsanitary actions will be permitted.

No persons with infectious or communicable diseases, sores or bandages will be admitted.

No abusive language or improper behavior will be tolerated; nor will excessive noise or music which interferes with the comfort and enjoyment of the facility by other users.

Trash must be placed in the receptacles provided.

Smoking is prohibited except in the designated areas. Ashes and cigarette butts must be properly disposed of in the cigarette post receptacles provided.

So as not to disturb others, individuals must play any audio equipment either at low volume <u>OR</u> use headphones/ear piece to listen to radios, music, MP3's, and other such audio equipment in the pool area.
