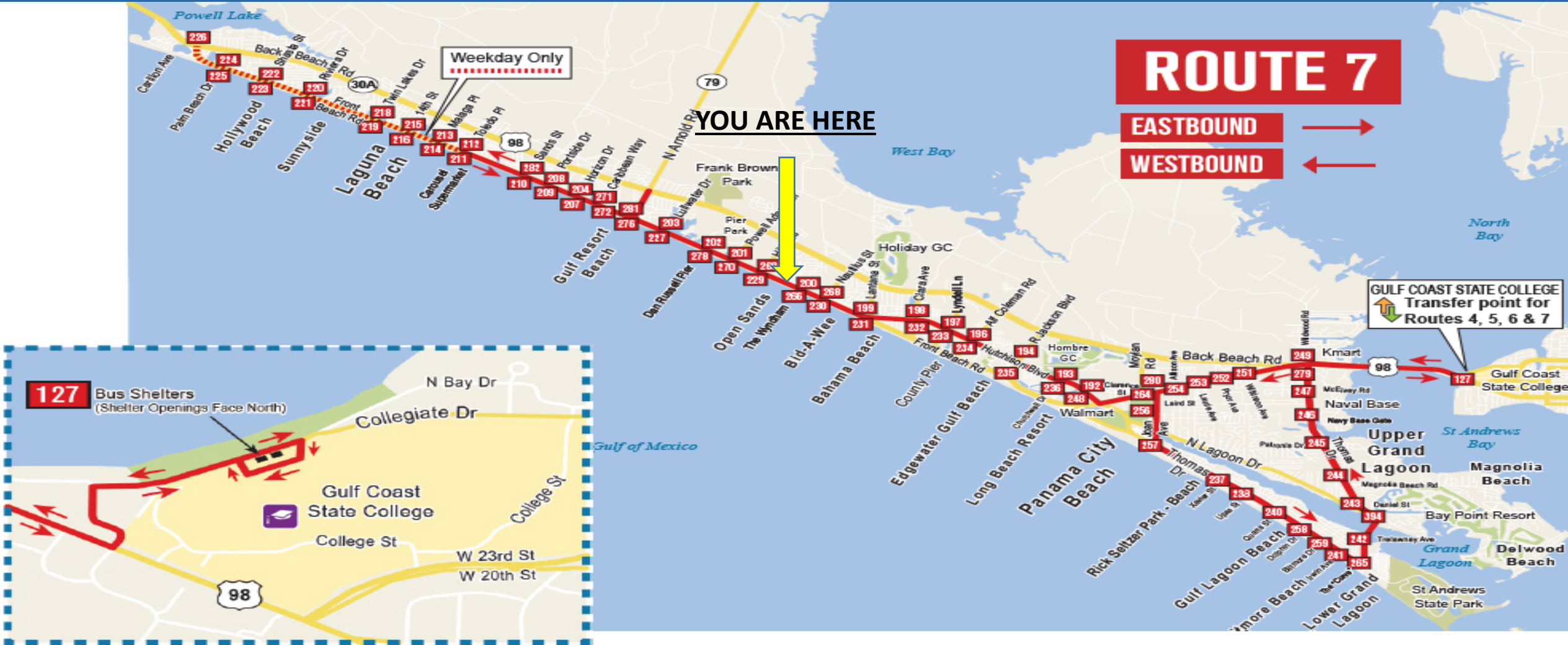

- **Route 7 operates 2 trolleys on SATURDAYS during the busy season between Memorial Day and Labor Day.**
- **One makes roundtrips during the day, departing from stop 233 (County Pier) at 5:50 a.m., last departure is from stop 211 (Laguna Beach) at 7:15 p.m. The trolley makes round trips during the day. All stops are serviced once every two hours.**
- **The first WESTBOUND stop at EBR is approximately 6:50 AM. The first EASTBOUND stop at EBR is also approximately 6:50 AM.**
- **The 2nd trolley makes only one roundtrip in the morning and one roundtrip in the afternoon. The morning trolley departs stop 127 at 6:30 AM. The afternoon trolley departs stop 127 at 2:30 PM.**
- **Route 7 operates only one trolley during the off-season. The trolley follows the same route and time schedule as trolley one during the busy season.**
- **NOTE: (Stops 226, 225, 224, 223, 222, 221, 220, 219, 218, 216, 215, 214, 213 and 203 are not serviced on Saturdays)**

FARES

Hopping on board Bay Town Trolley is a breeze! You can purchase your pass onboard any bus/trolley, by calling (850) 769-0557 or at our office. All vehicles are equipped with electronic fare boxes. The fare boxes do not make change, so we recommend having exact change.
