## **Article I. Goal**

**Section 1.01 The River Chase Homeschool is open to all interested property owners. The purpose of the club is as follows:**

- (a) Promote social opportunities for children and parents who live in River Chase**

- (d) Present occasions for field trips**

## **Article II. Rules**

### **Section 2.01 Group Members**

**In order to promote a positive image for Homeschool Group members and their families, as well as enhance the experience of everyone who participates, here are a few guidelines:**

- (a) All children participating in group activities must be accompanied by a responsible caretaker or arrangements made with another parent in the group.**
- (b) The group must maintain a 51% ratio of River Chase residents. Guests are welcome to attend activities, but please only invite one family per River Chase family.**
- (c) In order to encourage respect for the community, please be aware of and follow all rules for the clubhouse, courts, swimming pool, and parks.**
